Assembly Area and Route

Route: Gillespie -- McArthur -- Young -- Masters -- Recreation Grounds (past side show alley)

Participants are to assemble on Gillespie Street in front of the Moura State High School. Participants travelling on floats must not access the truck until stationary at the assembly area.

- Parade participants will finish behind the cattle yards/side show alley area
- Trucks/vehicles can exit through the back gates onto McRae street
- To gain access back into the festival you will have to enter through the main gate next to skate park and pay entry fee

Rules & Regulations

- Instructions of Police Officers and Coal Festival Co-ordinators are to be obeyed
- Children under 16 years old must be under the supervision of a responsible adult
- Assemble outside of the High School by 8.30am on the 17th August, 2024. Judging commences at 9.00am. **Procession departs at 9.30 am Sharp.** Children don't need to be on floats until 9.00am
- Possession of or consumption of alcoholic drinks is prohibited.
- Each participant must have a water bottle.
- All people, vehicles and organisations entering the parade MUST be registered with the committee
- All vehicles must be roadworthy and registered with either normal road or club registration.
- All vehicles must remain below 25kph at all times and maintain a minimum 5 metre separation.
- All other participants are to keep a safe distance from other parade participants at all times with no overtaking allowed.
- Walking children are to be strictly supervised by an adult.
- Children are not permitted to ride bicycles or scooters in the parade
- No objects to be thrown or tossed from any float or by any float participant while participating in the parade, whether riding on the float or walking alongside
- Any promotional material/sweets must be handed out by people walking
- Nothing shall be done to encourage or entice children or parade spectators onto the street or parade route No participant shall get on or off a moving float
- All parade participants to keep to the centre of the road where possible.
- No unrestrained livestock will be permitted in the parade.
- Vehicle must be operated in a safe manner (all wheels must stay on the ground)
- Follow the route set put by the Police and Festival Co-ordinator
- All props must be secure on all vehicles
- All people riding in vehicles must be seated at all times
- Each organisation must have a list of all people participating in the parade and written consent must be given by parent/guardian of any underage child, this is to be obtained by the float's co-ordinator prior to the day.
- I give permission for 'Moura Coal and Country Festival' to take and use photos of the participants, for the sole purpose of publicity, illustration, advertising and web content associated with this organisation
- In the event of an incident on the day, a list of all participants (including permission forms signed by parents/guardians of underage children) must be handed in to the Parade Co-ordinator **immediately.**
